

The Abbotsford Centre will be following the British Columbia Public Health Order, to enter certain spaces, including indoor ticketed sporting events and concerts, people aged 12 and older will be required to show their proof of vaccination with a valid government ID.

We will require the following from individuals to access the Abbotsford Centre.

- Provide proof of vaccination with valid government ID
- Required to wear a mask and always keep it on while in the venue
 - Mask must cover mouth and nose

As of September 13, one dose of the vaccine will be required for entry to the Abbotsford Centre. This includes the 90's Nostalgia Electric Circus Edition on September 20, 2021.

By October 24, entry to these settings will require people to be fully vaccinated. You are considered fully vaccinated 7 days after dose 2.

BC Government will allow people to use the vaccine card they received when getting a COVID shot as proof of immunization starting September 13 until September 26 as part of plan to move to a BC vaccine card. As of September 27, you will be required to have the BC Vaccine Card.

Once you receive your BC Vaccine Card, you can save a digital copy of your card to your cell phone or print a copy and keep it with you. If you do not have a cell phone, you can order a paper copy by phone at 1-833-838-2323 or visit the BC Service Centre.

If you are visiting from outside British Columbia, and are a Canadian visitor:

People from other Canadian provinces or territories must show:

- Provincially/territorially officially recognized vaccine record
- Valid government ID from the same province or territory

If you are an International visitor, including the USA:

International visitors must show:

- Proof of vaccination they used to enter Canada
- Passport

Please Note: The Canucks Sports & Entertainment (CSE) have announced their vaccination program that will require all guests, employees and event staff to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination prior to entry to Rogers Arena and Abbotsford Centre for all games, concerts and live events.

The CSE Vaccination Program will be in place during the Vancouver Canucks Training Camp on September 23-25, the Vancouver Canucks Pre-Season Game on September 27 and the Abbotsford Canucks Season including their home opener on Friday, October 22.
