



SHOW VACCINATION PROTOCOL

[British Columbia]

As of September 22, 2021

Live Nation Canada requires full vaccination against Covid-19 by its staff, workers, vendors, and providers in all areas of all venues for all Live Nation Canada promoted and co-promoted shows at all times during load-in, show, and load-out.

Full vaccination requires 2 doses of a Health Canada approved vaccine, with the second dose being administered at least 14 days prior to accessing or working at the venue.

Proof of vaccination is the BC Vaccine Card which can be a paper version or electronic version showing the persons' name, vaccination status, and QR code. A persons' identity must be validated via government issued photo ID. All staff, workers, vendors, and providers must bring their BC Vaccine Card and ID to every show or shift for them to be checked by a Live Nation representative. Persons who show up at any venue for work without their BC Vaccine Card and ID will not be allowed on site and will not be paid.

Live Nation encourages compliance with all local, regional, and national health guidance and regulations. The use of masks is required where mandated by provincial regulation.

Deliveries / Inspectors / Officials on site for a 15-minute window or less will not be subject to Live Nation Canada COVID vaccination or testing protocols but must wear a mask at all times while on site.

If an employee is feeling unwell, experiencing any symptoms of COVID 19, has been in close contact with someone who has recently tested positive for COVID 19, and/or are mandated to quarantine, they must not attempt to access the venue.
